


The General Assembly








Objectives and activities in 2022



Objectives:

- To facilitate the set-up of international activities, ensuring win-win for the members and for EG (tenders, grants, networks...)
- To acquire new projects with the members, ensuring expansion of the activities of EG; new topics, new regions...
- Support the project's sustainability: helping the members implementing the projects, to plan post-project activities
- Support business development of the members

Activities in 2022:

- **3 meetings** (11 April, 11 July and 14 November 2022), usually around 20 participants at each meeting
- Preparation of NGI Enrichers proposal, jointly with many members. Set up of a business model
- Preparation of contribution for one proposal, EG was integrated by the members CIVITTA and EBN
- Integration of one EG member (EURelations), with own budget attracted from national sources, in the running project
- Discussed and identified direction for further developments of the members (through projects) and of EG
- Discussed and identified directions for new thematic groups or service of EG: training/coaching/education
- Put in place overview of the members (Form A), to know better their main focus, skills, main references
- Funding Opportunities Watch service put in place for the members (Horizon Europe Programme), offered by SPI, Portugal
- **Tender Opportunities Watch** service for the EG members out in place. 3 free subscriptions offered by PEDAL Consulting, Slovakia. Used by ENRICH GLOBAL and shared with the members

Objectives

Facilitate international cooperation and policy dialogue on global health issues by harnessing the networking potential and critical mass of ENRICH Global members and their projects.

The ENRICH Global Health Innovation Group works as an expert-driven and long-lasting umbrella mechanism to enhance international cooperation and policy dialogue on global health issues. By planning and organizing the activities of the *International Experts Forum for Health Innovation*, the Group addresses R&I stakeholders in the field (Researchers, Care providers, Users/Patients Associations, Health Tech providers, etc.) and engage them in workshops and initiatives at international level inspired by open innovation and evidence-based policy making.

*Evidence-based policy making will be also favoured through the participation in the workshop of the R&I experts from the <u>International</u>
<u>Experts Forum for Health Innovation</u>.

Activities:



International Experts Forum for Health Innovation establishment and management: this will be done by leveraging on the <u>Health Innovation Community Platform</u> +500 stakeholders. Activities and events engaging the Forum (*1 Forum event per year, online*) will be planned through a Bi-annual Plan.

■ Target groups: Researchers, Care providers, Users/Patients Associations, Health Tech providers, etc.



International Policy Dialogue Workshops: (1 per year, online) to discuss about global Health challenges and compare Health policies, in a mutual learning and exchange environment that will also encourage eventual joint funding initiatives, to enhance international cooperation in specific sectors of Health*.





Description and Objectives



The main priority of this initiative focuses on collaboration and internationalisation development assistance for Ukrainian SMEs and other actors in the Ukrainian innovation ecosystem. This will be achieved by mobilising EG members and their partners, as well as any relevant organisation, to support the Action by facilitation of fundraising for the dedicated activities, and by offering short-term or mid-term consultancy contracts to relocated consultants.

The Specific Objective

is to increase partnerships and innovation internationalisation among the European and Ukrainian innovation ecosystem stakeholders.

- Output 1: Mobilized EG members and other stakeholders to support Ukrainian professional community relocated to the EU countries to soft-land
- Output 2: Secured funds for the implementation of activities
- Output 3: Integration of the Ukrainian research and tech industries into the Pan-European programmes
- Output 4: Facilitated access for Ukrainian research, technology and businesses looking for internationalisation to the EU and other global markets

Key activities in Y2022

Support UA displaced experts

- Raised 9500 EUR in cash and 20 days paid to Ukrainian displaced expert
- 2 junior staff from Ukraine hired fulltime by SPI, 2 more recommended with relocation
- EG hired 2 UA displaced consultants for the ARSINOE project
- EG contracted 2 UA displaced consultants to implement the Roadmap

The project will shape the pathways to resilience by bringing together the Systems Innovation Approach (SIA) and the Climate Innovation Window (CIW) to build an ecosystem for climate change adaptation solutions.

it has 41 partners, 9 case studies, budget 15 mln. euros and duration of 4 years (2021-2025)

- Support communities & scientists in evaluating the environmental & economic effects of climate change



ENRICH GLOBAL: some numbers - where we are at the end of 2022



- 5 part time staff or in house consultants
- 1 intern student (Science Po, Lille, France) starts in January 2023 full time
- 12 Board members
- 23 member organisations
- 38 countries where the members have physical presence, across the world
- 7 thematic groups proposed and led by the members' organisations
- 1 lighthouse initiative "Support Ukraine innovation"
- 2 projects secured and started, one more secured to start in 2023
- 8 member-organisations involved in these projects (Horizon Europe), in addition to ENRICH GLOBAL itself
- 3 staff at the accounting and audit agency takes care of financial, social and legal declarations
- Overall revenue secured in 2022 (for 2022-2025): 211.500 €
- Additionally, in-kind support secured in 2022 (contribution from the members for the development of ENRICH GLOBAL): equivalent of 297.600 €



Strategy outlook 2023



ASSOCIATION' LEVEL:

- Continue to keep focused membership strategy, by recommendations
- Continue contributory participation but for those who prefer to donate instead of in-kind contributions, this could be possible
- Reinforce management support at the acceleration phase (additional interns, part time staff ...)
- Set up reserve fund with clear rules
- Finetune procedures

MEMBERS' LEVEL

- Have first physical meeting of the members
- Reinforce collective action "members development" (business & project development, synergies, experience exchange...)
- Reinforce 'joint project' dimension with collaborative involvement of at least 2 members, and ENRICH GLOBAL when possible
- Review service portfolio for the members in 2023
- Focus simultaneously, when possible, on ENRICH GLOBAL development and members development (new topics, methods etc).



ENRICH GLOBAL - 2022 Budget



Contributory participation:

- Contributory participation of new members: no membership feed in 2022. Estimated in kind-contribution budget for 2022: 297 600€, including (average of 400€/person/day):
 - Desk members: 2 days/months (total: 4 members x 2 days/months)= 38 400€
 - Board members: 1 day/month (total: 12 members x 1 day/month x 12 months) = 57 600€
 - **Leader of each active thematic group**: 2 days/month (total: 6 active groups x 2 days/months x 12 months) = 57 600€
 - Other collective contribution from the active members to the thematic group: 5 days per group in total per year = 144 000€
- Donations: 9 500,68 €
- Project budget : 25 651.39 €
