The General Assembly (GA)

reunites all members of ENRICH GLOBAL: it **defines its general policy and approves the management** and financial accounts every year. The GA was organised on March 1st 2023.



The Board

is composed of <u>maximum 15 persons from the members' organisation</u> (currently 11 elected persons), it meets twice a year and decides among other things on the <u>implementation of the general policy</u>, approves new members, elect the desk's members and control their management.

Two board meetings were organised in 2023 (on July 6th and on November 23rd)



The Desk (Bureau)

is the executive management of ENRICH GLOBAL, responsible for the effective day-today functioning of the association in conformity with the general policy defined by the General Assembly and in application of the decisions of the Board.

A vehicle to work together



- ➤ ENRICH GLOBAL's Thematic Groups bring together members of the association, experts and worldclass actors, contributing to international research, innovation, and business collaboration, who share the vision to provide a unique collaborative platform based on best internationalisation practices
- Thematic Groups may be initiated by any member of the association and are moderated by them. There shall be at least 3 members interesting in the Thematic group activities.
- To initiate a Thematic Group, interested members (lead of the future Group) shall complete the template, available in the ENRICH GLOBAL Teams, and send it to the Desk members. The Thematic Group proposal will be presented by the Desk to the next Board meeting for approval by the Board.
- Thematic Groups includes only the Members of the association and (by invitation) the members of the members. However, the Groups may also include external participants under a specific umbrella initiated by the Group: e.g., International Forum, Community, Expert Group, etc.
- External participants can be invited at the discretion of Thematic Groups leaders for specific meetings

Facilitate international cooperation and policy dialogue on global health issues by harnessing the networking potential and critical mass of ENRICH Global members and their projects.

The ENRICH Global Health Innovation Group works as an expert-driven and long-lasting umbrella mechanism to enhance international cooperation and policy dialogue on global health issues. By planning and organizing the activities of the *International Experts Forum for Health Innovation*, the Group addresses R&I stakeholders in the field (Researchers, Care providers, Users/Patients Associations, Health Tech providers, etc.) and engage them in workshops and initiatives at international level inspired by open innovation and evidence-based policy making.

*Evidence-based policy making will be also favoured through the participation in the workshop of the R&I experts from the <u>International</u>

Experts Forum for Health Innovation.

Activities:



International Experts Forum for Health Innovation establishment and management: this will be done by leveraging on the <u>Health Innovation Community Platform</u> +600 stakeholders. Activities and events engaging the Forum (1 Forum event per year, online) will be planned through a Biannual Plan.

 Target groups: Researchers, Care providers Users/Patients Associations. Health Tech providers, etc.



International Policy Dialogue Workshops: (1 per year, online) to discuss about global Health challenges and compare Health policies, in a mutual learning and exchange environment that will also encourage eventual joint funding initiatives, to enhance international cooperation in specific sectors of Health*.

Discussions with the group in mid 2023 to explore a renewed direction which would focus on supporting, in particular, soft landing and mobility activities (as the ENRICH projects for the most part coming to the end of their EU funding period) and this could be one sustainable activity that the ENRICH community could support.

A proposal was made at the ENRICH GLOBAL Board Meeting (23/11/23) to join forces and merge the Internationalisation and Higher Education Groups into one, with the suggestion that it could be renamed "Internationalization & Mobility of Innovation", led by Temple and supported by EBN.

The focus would be on the Internationalisation & Mobility of Innovation, leveraging Research Institutions and Innovation Actors with the goal to build entrepreneurial mindset through global exchange and activities

Willingness to lead and operate the new group ""Internationalization & Mobility of Innovation" will be confirmed by Temple University to the Board in 2024 or later on; when the group is ready to start activities.

Objectives, activities, plans for 2024



- The group aims to foster international collaboration in the application of digital technologies, including AI and machine learning, Big Data, 5G and beyond, Internet of trust and security, IoT, Cloud/ Edge computing, modelling, simulation and optimization, high performance computing, to support reaching the targets of climate neutrality, circularity and zero pollution, e.g. in smart cities and communities, energy systems, industrial production, mobility, agriculture.

- ✓ Enhanced the initial network emerging from the initial event in Brussels carried out in cooperation with DLR Project Management Agency (see: https://www.iqib.de/de/urban-diplomacy-stadte-als-akteure-in-der-internationalen-zusammenarbeit-starken.html) with policy shapers on urban diplomacy, now involving additional municipal partners from Berlin, Bonn, Bordeaux, Dortmund, and Brussels
- ✓ Connection with the German Marshall Fund on city diplomacy initiatives and the City Diplomacy Lab in Paris
- Developed an innovation academy portfolio across 5 innovating dimensions within 2 idea crafting meetings with interested partners
- Recognized obstacles such as partners' different expectations for business models, time needed to prepare materials, etc.
- ✓ Yet, identified value as a valorisation channel for project results (e.g., ENRICH in the USA, TRIFOLD 2.0 (IQIB)) à decision to build innovation academy as a valorisation platform of project results firstly

ENRICH GLOBAL Collaboration Platform in a nutshell



The **ENRICH GLOBAL Collaboration Platform** (EGCP, provisional name) is the one-stop shop for any (project-related or not) community of stakeholders, fully customizable to be **tailored to each community needs (verticals: environment, digital, health, ... horizontal: public procurement, innovation academy...).**

The platform for communities / communities of practice:

- Unique opportunity for users to have all features in a single platform (no more multiple platforms to be setup for each new project by EG members)
- No need to develop specific platforms per project/community
- Available as PaaS (Platform as a Service): fast community setup!
- User interface can be customized to have a **per-community identity**
- Step-by-step, agile development

Data stored on EU servers

- Compliant with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Data owned by each community (lead organisation, project consortium...)
- Hosting, maintenance and backup provided by the ENRICH GLOBAL tech team

ENRICH GLOBAL (EG) Collaboration Platform: value for our members



- Free usage of most features for EG members, their members and for the partners of the projects who funds the development of the platform / communities!
- EG members and their members will be able to set up and operate e-communities (personalised space) <u>free of charge:</u>
 - The "owner(s)" of the community will set it up, moderate it, provide content (e.g. within the project), use it for replication of results created by EG members and their projects + for sustainability: the community continues even after the project!
 - ENRICH GLOBAL provides design and technical support funded in the projects of ENRICH GLOBAL, including future projects of the members.
 - Additional support could be provided to the members (project-based): digital marketing, community management...
- Additional value-added services for EG members, their projects and their members: virtual fairs to showcase online innovative solutions, products, technologies..., meet, share and collaborate with partners in 3D virtual spaces; Al-generated newsletter on topics of interest, ... upcoming in 2024-2025.
 - These additional value-added features requiring additional IT costs or specific proprietary tools will be organised through the joint projects in which EG is involved with the relevant member, or through the individual projects (in case the EG member requires such additional features).
